### Compiler's notes

This discography chronicles the recording work of the amateur body of singers known first as the "London Symphony Orchestra Chorus" or "L.S.O. Chorus" and, later, as the "London Symphony Chorus". It does not include records made prior to, and even during, 1966 by a professional 'pick-up' chorus using the same name. Within these terms of reference, I believe the discography to be complete. It should be noted that in some of the chorus's earlier recordings professional singers were used to reinforce the amateurs; this practice ceased when Equity disallowed it. Sometimes the presence of the professionals was acknowledged (as in entry 23), but usually not.

The chronological section is divided into four parts, corresponding to the periods of office of the four chorus masters/directors of music. Dates in brackets after release numbers refer to reviews in *Gramophone*; these give approximate dates of issue and may be of reference interest to those who have access to back copies of the magazine. U.K. releases on LP, CD, SACD and DVD-Audio are included, but not those on cassette, cartridge tape, DAT or DCC. Appendix 1 lists video discs, but not VHS tapes. As will be seen, I have used the standard 3-hour recording session (or part of a session) as the 'unit of work'.

The names of soloists are mentioned only when they recorded with the Chorus in the studio but not if they merely happen to be featured in the same work or on the same record (except where this is in doubt). Chorus members have occasionally been asked to undertake small solo parts; although not credited by the recording companies concerned I have thought it proper to include them here.

Some confusion may be felt over the slightly different casts given for Bernstein's *Candide* in entries 74 and 2A. The Abbey Road sessions were plagued with illness, with other singers apparently taking over in certain ensemble passages. The casts given are the most accurate that I can ascertain, not having been there in person, and not knowing exactly what DG used in the make-up of the master tape.

I should like to thank the long-serving members of the Chorus who have searched their memories and their diaries to clarify for me certain details concerning, particularly, the earlier recording activities.
